Minutes of the Meeting

Agenda: Pre-Bid Meeting
Venue: Committee Room, University of Swabi
Date and Time: 17/10/2025 at 11:00 A.M

The Pre-Bid meeting of the work "Installation of Solar PV System 450 KW (On Grid Hybrid) in Women University Swabi (Main Campus)" of the projects titled "Establishment of Women University Swabi ADP Scheme No. 130548" was held under the chairmanship of Treasurer, convener of the Committee constituted vide No. WUS/REG/2025/2045 dated. 07/10/2025 for Opening and Evaluation of Bids at 11:00 A.M on 17/10/2025 in Committee Room, Women University Swabi (Main Campus). The list of the participants is attached.

The meeting was started with recitation of few verses from The Holy Quran, the participants were welcomed by the convener and emphasized about agenda of the meeting. The Deputy Director Works informed the Committee that the Bids Solicitation Documents of the instant work has been uploaded on E-PAD dated.09/10/2025, the Tender Notice has been published in the daily newspapers "The News" and "Mashriq" on 11/10/2025 and uploaded on KPPRA's and Women University Swabi's official websites accordingly. He also added that the purpose of the meeting is to address query(ies), if any regarding the work and its Bids Solicitation Documents.

The following Agenda items were discussed in detail in the meeting:

Agenda Item No.1: - Performance Security

Discussion: -

The Performance Security to be furnished by the successful bidder was discussed in length. The participants were informed that the performance Security is mandatory as per prevailing Government Rules; hence the heading of IB 34 may be read as "Performance Security" instead of "Performance Security (Not Applicable)".

Decision and recommendations: -

It was decided and recommended that the Heading of IB 34 be read as "Performance Security" instead of "Performance Security (Not Applicable)"

Agenda Item No.2: - Completion Period

Discussion: -

The completion period, which has been decided by the Employer and the Consultant as 45 days in the Bids Solicitation Documents, which was discussed and the bidders requested in writing that the completion period may be increased. After a thorough discussion, all the participants were agreed with the request of the bidders and as such the Committee was agreed that the completion period of execution of work will be increased from 45 days to 90 days.

Decision and recommendations: -

It was decided and recommended that the completion period of the work will be Ninety (90) days instead of Forty-Five (45) days.



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Agenda Item No. 03: - Company Experience

Discussion: :-

The Evaluation Criteria mentioned in the Bids Solicitation Documents was also brought under discussion; the bidders were of the opinion that criteria may be modified as the amount of the completed projects i.e Rs. 100 Million may be replaced by the capacity i.e Kilo Watts.

Decision and Recommendations: :-

It was decided and recommended that the Criteria mentioned in the bids solicitation Documents be read as:

“Solar Hybrid / Off Grid System Projects completed in last 05 years.

Note: Each project must be 500 Kilo Watts or worth Rs. 100 Million and above for consideration. Attach copy of Work Order, Contract Agreement Form and Completion / Performance Certificate (duly attested)

Solar Projects including Solar Hybrid / Off Grid Systems involving Lithium Batteries shall be considered for evaluation Only. LOA/Work Order, Contract Agreement and BOQ to be attached as supporting documents.

Solar Pumping, Solar On-Grid System, Solar Street Lights, DC SHS System or Other nature Solar Projects will not be considered for evaluation. That projects will be considered and marks will be awarded, where a project of 500 Kilo Watts or above has been completed in a single location.”

Instead of:

“Solar Hybrid / Off Grid System Projects completed in last 05 years.

Note: Each project must be of Rs. 100 million PKR or above for consideration. Attach copy of Work Order, Contract Agreement Form and Completion / performance Certificate (duly attested) Solar Projects including Solar Hybrid / Off Grid Systems involving Lithium Batteries shall be considered for evaluation Only. LOA/Work Order, Contract Agreement and BOQ to be attached as supporting documents.

Solar Pumping, Solar On-Grid System, Solar Street Lights, DC SHS System or Other nature Solar Projects will not be considered for evaluation. ”

Agenda Item No. 04: - Eligibility Criteria/Marks

Discussion: :-

The Eligibility Criteria/Passing Marks was discussed and after mutual consensus, the Committee was agreed to lower the Passing Marks under the permissible limit of the Pakistan Engineering Council Standard Criteria and as per Practice in Vogue.

Decision and Recommendations: :-

It was decided and recommended that the Passing Marks/Criteria be read as:

“The bidder must secure at least 50% marks in each category and Overall 60% marks for qualifying. If an applicant secures less than 50% marks in any category, they will be considered disqualified and their financial bids will be returned unopened.”

Instead of:

“The bidder must secure at least 60% marks in each category and Overall 75% marks for qualifying. If an applicant secures less than 60% marks in any category, they will be considered disqualified and their financial bids returned unopened”.

And

"Note: If the rates quoted by two or more bidders are same, the bidder with the highest technical score will be awarded the project."

Instead of:

"Note: If the rates quoted by two or more bidders are same, the bidder will be awarded the contract through Draw/Toss."

Agenda Item No. 05: - Joint Venture

Discussion: -

The Bidders also requested that the Joint Venture may be allowed, however after a thorough discussion, the Committee was of the opinion that the instant work is not of very big nature in respect of cost and capacity, hence the sole contractor in this regard is suitable to execute the work.

Decision & Recommendation: -

It was decided and recommended that Joint Venture is not allowed as stated in the Bids Solicitation Documents.

Agenda Item No. 06: - Annual Turn Over and Tax Returns

Discussion: -

The Annual Turn Over and Tax Returns valuing Rs. 200 Million as incorporated in the Basic Eligibility Criteria (Mandatory Requirements) has been discussed. The bidders were of the opinion that the clause of Annual Turn Over may be removed from the Basic Eligibility Criteria (Mandatory Requirements), as it has also been added in the Detail Criteria of Financial Soundness, where marks has been allotted to it. However, the Committee informed the bidders that Annual Turn Over clause in the Basic Eligibility Criteria (Mandatory Requirements) will remain intact. The Committee thoroughly reviewed the amount and agreed with amount of Rs. 150 Million instead of Rs. 200 Million.

Decision & Recommendation: -

It was decided and recommended that the amount Rs. 200 Million as per clause at serial No.12 of Basic Eligibility Criteria (Mandatory Requirements) be read as Rs. 150 Million.

Minutes of the Meeting of the Grievance Redressal Committee

Day First

The 3rd meeting of the Grievance Redressal Committee was held on November 05, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. in the office of the Controller of Examinations. The meeting was chaired by Mr. Bakht Rahman, Additional Controller and Convener of the Committee. The following members attended the meeting:

Mr. Tayyab ur Rehman, Additional Registrar

Mr. Wasif Anees, Deputy Director Audit

Certain complaints were raised by the Sustainable Energy Pvt Limited through EPAD. The print is attached with the minutes.

The committee collected the documents regarding bidding process from the procurement section. All the documents were checked in detail and the committee thoroughly examined the objections raised by the said firm.

The committee was also informed by DDI works that according to KPRA rules a pre-bid meeting shall be held in five working days; however, the Works department gave them ten working days for the said meeting. A pre-bid meeting was held on 22-10-2025 and all the bidders attended the meeting. Moreover, they also give their objections/grievances in written form (copy attached). However, the said firm uploaded more complaints on 23-10-2025 (copy attached).

Decision:

It was decided to call the procurement officer as well as the complainant in the next meeting. The committee summoned the aggrieved bidder as well as the procurement officer for a hearing, and they were accordingly intimated to appear before the committee on November 06, 2025.

Day Second

The 4th meeting of the committee was held on November 06, 2025, in the office of the Controller of Examinations. However, the complainant didn't show up.


Decision:

The committee, therefore, unanimously decided that the bidding was transparent and according to the PEC and KPRA rules. The complainant had requested to remove the average turnover of last five years i.e. 200 million in the advertisement which was reduced to 150 million. The next objection was to count the experience in kilo watts which has been done accordingly during the pre-bid meeting.


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The complaints put forward certain other grievances on EPAD after the pre-bid meeting which have no value since the meeting was conducted for the said purpose.


In light of the above deliberations, the committee unanimously concluded that the complaint is baseless and therefore stands null and void.

Subject: GRIEVANCE AGAINST TECHNICAL EVALUATION & REQUEST FOR RE-EVALUATION

Dear Sir,

With due respect, we, **M/s TSK Engineering International (Pvt.) Ltd.**, hereby submit this formal grievance under **THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA PUBLIC PROCUREMENT GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL RULES, 2017**, regarding the technical evaluation results communicated to us vide your letter No. **DDW/DoW/WUS/2025/214** dated **02-12-2025**, wherein our firm was declared *technically non-responsive* on the basis of "insufficient experience record."

We strongly contest this determination, as it is inconsistent with:

1. The **Technical Evaluation Criteria** stipulated in the bidding documents.
2. The **clarifications and modifications mutually agreed during the Pre-Bid Meeting held on 17/10/2025** at Women University Swabi.
3. The **documented and verifiable experience** submitted by our firm, fully aligned with the criteria approved in the *Pre-Bid Meeting Minutes* (attached to the bidding documents and signed by your committee).

1. INCORRECT APPLICATION OF EXPERIENCE CRITERIA

Your evaluation awarded our firm **08/30 marks** in the category "Experience Record" and declared this category as **FAILED** on grounds of obtaining less than 50% marks. However, this conclusion **does not reflect the experience evidence submitted by us**, nor the **criteria clarified and finalized** in the *Pre-Bid Meeting Minutes*.

As per the Pre-Bid Meeting Minutes (Page 2 of 3) (**attached at Annex-1**), the Company Experience Criteria was revised by the Procurement Committee. As per the pre-bid meeting minutes, the revised criteria is as follows:

Agenda Item No. 03: - Company Experience**Discussion: -**

The Evaluation Criteria mentioned in the Bids Solicitation Documents was also brought under discussion; the bidders were of the opinion that criteria may be modified as the amount of the completed projects i.e Rs. 100 Million may be replaced by the capacity i.e Kilo Watts.

Decision and Recommendations: -

It was decided and recommended that the Criteria mentioned in the bids solicitation Documents be read as:

"Solar Hybrid / Off Grid System Projects completed in last 05 years.

Note: Each project must be 500 Kilo Watts or worth Rs. 100 Million and above for consideration. Attach copy of Work Order, Contract Agreement Form and Completion / Performance Certificate (duly attested)

Solar Projects including Solar Hybrid / Off Grid Systems involving Lithium Batteries shall be considered for evaluation Only. LOA/Work Order, Contract Agreement and BOQ to be attached as supporting documents.

Solar Pumping, Solar On-Grid System, Solar Street Lights, DC SHS System or Other nature Solar Projects will not be considered for evaluation. That projects will be considered and marks will be awarded, where a project of 500 Kilo Watts or above has been completed in a single location."

Our company has provided experience record in line with the above-mentioned criterion, where work orders worth **Rs. 100 Million or above (Solar Off Grid System)** with **Government Department** involving **Lithium Batteries** were attached for your consideration. The fulfilment of these requirements should be sufficient for consideration of an experience record as **Valid** and should have resulted in securing full marks as per the criteria.

Despite providing all required and verifiable proof, our experience score was drastically and unjustifiably reduced to **only 08 marks**, which does not align with the agreed evaluation criteria or our submitted documentation.

We have re-checked our submitted proposals and came to this conclusion that the client has applied the technical evaluation criteria incorrectly, confusing the requirement for Experience Record and applied the condition "**Project of 500kW or above completed in a Single Location**" on all experience record.

The experience criteria outlined in both the bidding documents and the Pre-Bid Meeting Minutes are unequivocal and leave no room for misinterpretation. It is important to emphasize that the two conditions stated in the Minutes are **mutually exclusive**. A bidder may qualify by submitting **either** a Work Order for a single-site project of **500 kW or higher**, or evidence of projects valued at **PKR 100 million or above** involving Lithium Battery systems. These criteria are independent of one another and were intended to provide alternate pathways for demonstrating relevant experience.

As our company have attached valid experience record along with all supporting documents clearly depicting the 100M or above worth, Government Sector Experience and involving Lithium Batteries, there is no reason for rejecting our experience record.

2. DEVIATION FROM KPPRA PRINCIPLES OF FAIRNESS, TRANSPARENCY AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

Under KPPRA Rules, technical evaluation must be:

- **Consistent with the criteria shared with all bidders,**
- **Transparent,**
- **Non-discriminatory, and**



- Based strictly on documentary evidence submitted.

The awarding of only 8 marks to our extensive experience suggests:

- Either the evaluation criteria were **not applied correctly**, or
- Our submitted documents were **not reviewed in detail**, or
- The evaluation committee **misinterpreted the mutually agreed criteria** recorded in the official Pre-Bid Minutes.

This constitutes a **material deviation** from KPPRA Rules and undermines the transparency and fairness required in public procurement.

3. OUR REQUEST:

In light of the above, we respectfully request:

a. Re-Evaluation of Our Technical Proposal

Specifically the category "**Experience Record**", by applying:

- The **revised and mutually agreed criteria** as recorded in the Pre-Bid Meeting Minutes, and
- The **documentary evidence already submitted** by our firm.

b. Suspension of the Procurement Process Until Grievance Disposal

As required under KPPRA Rules, the procurement process must remain **on hold** until this grievance is addressed and resolved.

4. Conclusion

We reiterate that **TSK Engineering International (Pvt.) Ltd.** meets—and exceeds—the experience requirements set forth in your bidding documents, as clarified during the official pre-bid meeting.

We firmly believe the evaluation contains a technical error and request its rectification to uphold **transparency, merit, and compliance with KPPRA Rules**.

We look forward to a fair and impartial review.

The committee collected the documents regarding bidding process from the procurement section. All the documents were checked in detail and the committee thoroughly examined the objection raised by the said firm.


